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LOWER SOUTH PLATTE WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2023 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE LOWER SOUTH PLATTE WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT, FOR THE 2024 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of the Lower South Platte Water Conservancy District has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on November 14, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operation expenses is \$700,583.95;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for refunds and abatements is \$ 0.00; and

WHEREAS, Lower South Platte Water Conservancy District finds that it is required to temporarily lower the general operating mill levy to render a refund for \$ 0.00 and,

WHEREAS, the 2023 valuation for assessment of the Lower South Platte Water Conservancy District, as certified by the County Assessor (s) is \$717,076,719.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Lower South Platte Water Conservancy District, Colorado:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Lower South Platte Water Conservancy District during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 1.000 mill upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2023 and that for refunds and abatements within the District for the year 2023, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.00 mills.


SECTION 2. That for the purpose of rendering a temporary general property tax credit during budget year 2024, hereby levied a temporary mill levy reduction of .023 mills.

SECTION 3. That the Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the county commissioners the mill levy for the Lower South Platte Water Conservancy District, as herein above determined and set based upon the final (December) certification of valuation from the county (s) assessor(s).
