Director Gerk seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

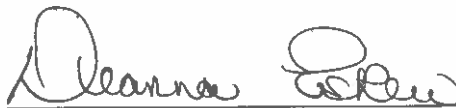
President Fritzler adjourned the executive session and reconvened the board meeting at approximately 1:30 p.m.
